

Any exhibitor who wishes to withdraw from the sale must notify the designated official during the allotted time. Pulls will be Saturday August 20, from 11-1 pm. If an animal is not withdrawn from the sale during allotted time, animal must go through sale. If an animal is removed from the sale without prior approval from the livestock committee, exhibitor may be banned from participating in future Expo livestock shows. If an animal is eligible for sale is withdrawn from the sale, the next highest placing animal in the class in which the withdrawn animal was shown will be eligible for sale. Any junior exhibitor having an animal entered in the sale is prohibited from seeking special privileges from buyers; such as asking permission to re-purchase the animal from the buyer or packer for the purpose of showing again or for other uses. Any exhibitor or their agent who harasses or seeks special privileges will be subject to disciplinary action as deemed necessary by the Expo board including withholding of sale money.

WHILE ANY SALE ANIMAL IS ON THE EXPO GROUNDS THE ONLY SALE TRANSACTION ALLOWED ON JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SALE DAY ARE THROUGH THE SALE RING.
