

JUNIOR LIVESTOCK MARKET MEAT GOAT RULES

1. See Junior Division General Livestock Rules
2. All male goats must be wethered. Does may be shown in this class with scrapies tag.
3. All Meat Goats will be groomed for the show with not more than 3/8 inch of hair over the hock.
4. Meat Goats will be judged for meat quality.
5. All Meat Goats must be tattooed and tagged with a NMLB approved tag.
6. All Meat Goats must have collars to be shown.
7. Classes will be divided by weights:
Minimum Weight - 40 Lbs.
Maximum Weight - 125 Lbs.
8. All Meat Goats with horns must be tipped to no smaller than a dime before arrival to the VCCEXpo show grounds.
9. Clipping is allowed on grounds, but electricity will not be provided. All clippings on the show premises will be properly disposed of by exhibitor. An approval of the clean-up is required by the Meat Goat Superintendent.
10. Only goats under one year of age are eligible to show in Junior Market Classes. At classification and weigh-in time, goats must have intact temporary incisors.
11. No dressing (such as oil, paint, or powder) other than water may be used. Any goat with dressing other than water will not be allowed to compete.
