

## **JUNIOR LIVESTOCK PYGMY GOAT RULES**

### Classes:

1. Wethers – 0 up to 12 months
2. Wethers – 1 year and older
3. Does – 0 up to 12 months
4. Does – 1 year and older

### Rules:

1. See Junior Division General Livestock Rules.
2. All Pygmy Goats older than 6 months of age, must be individually identified – legible tattoos, readable microchips or ear tags.
3. Animals entered in the Youth Pygmy Goat Show are not required to be registered with the National Pygmy Goat Association (NPGA) but will be judged according to the NPGA breed standard.
4. All male Pygmy Goats must be wethered.
5. Pygmy Goat exhibitors are required to wear dark pants and a light colored shirt while exhibiting.
6. Classes may be combined or divided as the Pygmy Goat Superintendent deems necessary.
7. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners of each class will compete for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Pygmy Goat.
8. All pygmy goats must be released by the Superintendent and removed from the VCC Expo grounds after completion of the show.
